Camp Rules & Information

Pardon Our Dust: We are a work in progress. You will see some areas in the process of being cleared. There may also be some parked machinery. Please keep kids and pets away from all machinery. We may do some light maintenance on weekends, but typically won't use use heavy equipment, or make lots of noise. Weekdays are when we do the heavier work. We try to time most heavy work when the camp is empty, but at sometime that isn't possible. We will always do our best to keep the noise down, and to work position ourselves to minimize impact on your enjoyment of the property.

Dogs: Well-behaved, friendly pets may be off leash when in the presence and under the control of the pet owner. We hope to allow your pets to enjoy their stay as well, but the comfort and safety of our guests is paramount. If any other guest is uncomfortable, and asks you to leash your dog, please do so. Also please clean up after your pet.

<u>Noise</u>: We ask that noise be kept to a reasonable level after 10pm, and very low after midnight. Some campsites are close to the road, so we ask that driving up and down the road cease @ midnight.

The Bridge: There is an old timber logging bridge crossing the creek near campsite #2. It is about 16' above the creek level and rotting away. It is NOT SAFE for ANY pedestrian or vehicle traffic. DO NOT go on or near this old bridge!

Decks: There are two decks overlooking the creek. They sit ~12-16 feet above the creek level. Though still sturdy, they are pretty old, and due for some maintenance. Please limit the number of people on them to no more than 4, and do not jump or climb on the railing. Use of these decks (as with all activities) is left to your sole discretion and conducted at your own risk.

Shooting Range: There is a small shooting range for private use only. It is currently off limits to Hipcamp guests, and there will be no firearms use while Hipcamp guests are present. We may in the future offer archery at this location to guests, but until the range is finished, and matters of insurance and liability are addressed this area is completely off limits.

<u>Campfires</u>: We feel that a nice campfire is a huge part of the camping experience and allow them through most of the year (unless local authorities prohibit them). Our ability to allow campfires rests with the care and responsibility of our guests. Please keep your fire attended at all times, and under control. Please keep the flames no more than 6" higher than the fire pit, and make sure it is completely doused and cold before leaving for any period of time (or at checkout).

Drugs and Alcohol: The property owners, and many of our friends and family who enjoy Zen Acre, are drug and alcohol free. Our guests are free to use legal substances in their campsites, but we ask that you refrain in communal areas of the campground. Most important to us is the atmosphere and "vibe". We welcome adults who partake of legal substances in a responsible manner, but we do NOT want a party atmosphere of any kind, nor campers to engage in substance abuse or belligerent behavior while on the premises. You will be asked to leave if this becomes an issue!

<u>Communication</u>: Most of the time you will see us passing through the camp area a couple times a day. If you need any-thing, or have any questions, feel free to flag any of us down, we are happy to help. We also monitor the Hipcamp messaging app pretty closely, so if you send us a message, we will usually see it and be able to respond within an hour or two (often much faster).
